

Message from SRCS sent on 1/11/2022:

Dear SRCS Families and Staff,

With a surge in COVID cases, Sonoma County's Health Officer has issued a new Health Order, effective January 12 through February 11, restricting gatherings. The new order does not apply to normal classroom or recess activities. However, the restrictions will extend to many school-related activities, such as athletic competitions, music and theater performances, dances, fundraising events and in-person assemblies.

We will be sharing information in the future about other activities, but this message will provide more information about the number of people who are allowed in school athletic events:

Effective January 12, 2022, in compliance with [Sonoma County Health Order C19-35](#), the following modifications to athletic attendance will be put into place for all Santa Rosa City Schools sporting events taking place between January 12 and February 11, 2022:

Indoor Sports (i.e., Basketball, Wrestling, Volleyball)

Attendance limited to coaches, student athletes and auxiliary staff only. Auxiliary staff includes scorekeepers, stat keepers, visiting drivers, scoreboard operators, officials and college scouts. Both schools must submit rosters of all people scheduled to attend prior to the contest. Santa Rosa City Schools administration reserves the right to limit entry should this number exceed 50.

Outdoor Sports (i.e., Soccer)

Attendance limited to 2 guests per student athlete, coaches, student athletes, and auxiliary staff. Auxiliary staff includes scorekeepers, stat keepers, visiting drivers, scoreboard operators, officials and college scouts. Both schools must submit rosters of all people scheduled to attend prior to the contest. Santa Rosa City Schools administration reserves the right to limit entry should this number exceed 100.

In order to keep the numbers within allowed limits, teams waiting to use indoor or outdoor spaces will not be allowed entrance into the venue until players from the prior contest have exited. To help facilitate this, there will be no post-game handshakes or meetings on the venue grounds.

We will keep you informed if anything changes. Thank you for your cooperation in ensuring that our students continue to have the opportunity to play!
